ORDINANCE NO. 1676

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 229 - STABLES - OF ORDINANCE NO. 1054, ENTITLED "GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KIRKWOOD, 1936", AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCES NOS. 1557 AND 1560, AND ENACTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AND NUMBERED AS SECTION 229 - STABLES - OF ORDINANCE NO. 1054, ENTITLED "GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KIRKWOOD, 1936".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKWOOD, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 229 - Stables - of Ordinance No. 1054, entitled "General Ordinances of the City of Kirkwood, 1936", as amended by Ordinances Nos. 1557 and 1560, be and the same is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof, there is enacted a new Section to be known and numbered as Section 229 - Stables - of Ordinance No. 1054, entitled "General Ordinances of the City of Kirkwood, 1936", said new Section to be entitled and enacted as follows:

"SECTION 229. It shall be unlawful for any person having charge or control of any stable, shed or apartment, or any yard or appurtenance thereto, in which any cattle, hogs, horses, mules, sheep, goats and other animals, and domestic geese, ducks, chickens, turkeys and other fowls are kept, or any place in which sewage or liquid discharges of such animals and fowls shall collect or accumulate, to fail to keep the same in a clean and wholesome condition, so that no offensive smell shall escape therefrom, and the violation of this Section by such person shall be deemed a nuisance; provided that nothing in this Section shall be so construed as to include manure deposits upon any private property for the purpose of cultivating the same; provided further, that the keeping of any stable, shed or apartment, or any yard or appurtenance thereto, in which any cattle, hogs, horses, mules, sheep, goats and other animals, and domestic geese, ducks, chickens, turkeys and other fowls are kept within fifty (50) feet of any dwelling or house is hereby declared to be a nuisance. It is understood that when the term "cattle, hogs, horses, mules, sheep, goats and other animals, and domestic geese, ducks, chickens, turkeys and other fowl" are used in this Section, the same is intended to and does include the singular."

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, as provided by law.
